 - ✓ San Dimas Ave. (northbound and southbound) will serve as the main detour route, see details below.
 - ✓ Bonita Ave. (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to all traffic.
 - ✓ Commercial St. (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to all traffic.


