#### LORAINE AVE. CROSSING WILL BE CLOSED FOR A FEW HOURS IN THE EARLY MORNING AND AFTERNOON FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 18

### **CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY**

As part of the 9.1-mile, four-station Foothill Gold Line light rail project, KPJV will be closing Loraine Ave. at the railroad crossing between Route 66 and Lemon Ave. for a few hours both in the early morning and in the afternoon of Friday, February 18. The morning closure window will be from **4:30 AM – 7:00 AM**, and the afternoon closure window will be from **12:00 PM – 3:00 PM**. Throughout the duration of each closure that day, traffic will be detoured to Elwood Ave. **WHERE** 

Loraine Ave. at the railroad crossing between Route 66 and Lemon Ave. in Glendora.

#### WHEN

On Friday, February 18, 2022, between the hours of 4:30 AM – 7:00 AM and 12:00 PM – 3:00 PM, Loraine Ave. at the railroad crossing between Route 66 and Lemon Ave. in Glendora will be fully closed to all traffic.

## **TRAFFIC ADVISORIES**

- Full closure of Loraine Ave. at the railroad crossing between Route 66 and Lemon Ave. between the hours of 4:30 AM 7:00 AM and 12:00 PM 3:00 PM on Friday, February 18, 2022.
- Elwood Ave. will serve as the detour route.
- Signage will be posted to direct motorists and pedestrians.

## PLAN YOUR ROUTE AND BE PREPARED

- A detour route (see map below) will be in place during the closure and signage will be posted to direct motorists and pedestrians. Please follow detour signs.
  - ✓ Loraine Ave. will be fully closed to all traffic at the railroad crossing between Route 66 and Lemon Ave.
  - $\checkmark$  Elwood Ave. (northbound and southbound) will serve as the main detour route, see details below.
  - ✓ Route 66 (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to all traffic.
  - ✓ Lemon Ave. (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to all traffic.

Noise from construction equipment will be produced near the active work zones.
