WHITE AVE. AT RAILROAD CROSSING NORTH OF ARROW HIGHWAY (CITY OF LA VERNE)
APRIL 8, 2022 (6 AM) - APRIL 10, 2022 (6 AM)

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

During the on-going full closure of White Ave. at the railroad crossing north of Arrow Highway, KPJV crews will work **around the clock (24 hours a day)** at the crossing from Friday morning, April 8th at 6:00 AM thru Sunday morning, April 10th at 6:00 AM. The around the clock work is taking advantage of a track outage planned by Metrolink, and will allow crews time to complete electrical improvements and upgrade the Metrolink track while the trains are not in service. This work requires both daytime and nighttime work shifts. As a reminder, the railroad crossing at White Ave. will remain fully closed for reconstruction thru April 30, 2022.

WHEN

- Friday, April 8th at 6:00 AM and continuing thru Sunday, April 10th at 6:00 AM
- Operations will be continuous and around the clock, crews will be working both day and night shifts

TRAFFIC ADVISORIES


- White Ave. will be fully closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic at the railroad crossing between Arrow Hwy. and 1st St.
- Access to homes and businesses on White Ave. within the closure area north and south of the railroad crossing will be
 maintained at all times, as will access to 1st St. north of the crossing and Sierra Way south of the crossing

PLAN YOUR ROUTE AND BE PREPARED

- The detour route (see map below) will remain in place during the remainder of the ongoing closure and signage is posted to direct motorists and pedestrians. Please follow detour signs.
 - ✓ White Ave. remains fully closed to all traffic at the railroad crossing between Arrow Hwy. and 1st St.
 - √ Wheeler Ave. (northbound and southbound) serves as the main detour route, see details below.
 - ✓ Arrow Hwy. (eastbound and westbound) remains open to thru traffic.
 - √ Foothill Blvd. (eastbound and westbound) remains open to thru traffic.

NOTE TO RESIDENTS / BUSINESS OWNERS

- Noise from construction equipment will be produced near the active work zones around the clock/24 hours from April 8 - 10, 2022.
