NOTICE: Full Street Closure

E ST. AT RAILROAD CROSSING (CITY OF LA VERNE) JUNE 6 - JUNE 20, 2022

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

As part of the 9.1-mile Foothill Gold Line light rail project, crews will return to complete reconstructing the railroad crossing on E St. (north of Arrow Hwy.) in the city of La Verne. Crews will complete the installation of a second light rail track, build a new right turn pocket from westbound Arrow Hwy. to northbound E St., and rebuild the roadway, curbs & gutters. This work requires a **full closure of E St. at the railroad crossing for approximately 2 weeks.** Crews removed and relocated the freight track, installed one light rail track and completed utility work during a fourmonth closure in Spring 2021.

WHEN

Beginning Monday, June 6th and continuing daily thru June 20th, 2022, E St. will be fully closed to all traffic (vehicular and pedestrian) at the railroad crossing 24 hours a day/7 days a week.

• Crews plan to work daily from 7:00 AM - 12:00 AM. Overnight work and Sunday shifts may also be required.

TRAFFIC ADVISORIES


- E St. will be fully closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic at the railroad crossing just north of Arrow Hwy...
- Access to homes and businesses on E St. within the closure area north and south of the railroad crossing will be maintained at all times, as well as access to the University of La Verne, 1st St., 2nd St., and 3rd St.

PLAN YOUR ROUTE AND BE PREPARED

- A detour route (see map below) will be in place during the closure and signage will be posted to direct motorists and pedestrians. Please follow detour signs.
 - ✓ E St. will be fully closed to all traffic at the railroad crossing between Arrow Hwy, and Bonita Ave.
 - ✓ White Ave. (northbound and southbound) will serve as the main detour route, see details below.
 - ✓ Arrow Hwy. (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to thru traffic with reduced lanes.
 - ✓ Bonita Ave. (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to all traffic.

NOTE TO RESIDENTS / BUSINESS OWNERS

- Noise from construction equipment will be produced near the active work zones.
- Bus stops may be temporarily relocated, for more information:
