NOTICE: Full Directional Lane Closures

WHITE AVE. AT RAILROAD CROSSING (CITY OF LA VERNE) DECEMBER 20 - 22, 2022

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

As part of the 9.1-mile Foothill Gold Line light rail project, crews will return to complete the final paving and striping of the roadway at the railroad crossing on White Ave. (north of Arrow Hwy) in the city of La Verne. This work requires the full closure of the northbound and/or southbound lanes on White Ave. intermittently (only one direction will be closed at a time).

WHEN

Beginning Tuesday, December 20th and continuing daily thru Thursday, December 22nd, 2022, the northbound and/or southbound lanes on White Ave. north of Arrow Hwy. will be fully closed intermittently during daytime working hours (one direction will be closed at a time). Foothill Blvd. (north of the crossing) and Arrow Hwy. (south of the crossing) will remain open and accessible by way of detour routes. See map below

• Work Hours: 7:00 AM - 9:00 PM. NOTE: Occasional longer work hours may be performed during these closures. All scheduled work is subject to weather and rescheduling.

TRAFFIC ADVISORIES

- Northbound and/or southbound lanes on White Ave. will be fully closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic at the railroad crossing intermittently (one direction will be closed at a time).
- Access to homes and businesses on White Ave. within the closure area north and south of the railroad crossing will be maintained at all times.

PLAN YOUR ROUTE AND BE PREPARED

- A detour route (see map below) will be in place during the closure and signage will be posted to direct motorists and pedestrians. Please follow detour signs.
 - ✓ White Ave. will be fully closed intermittently to northbound/southbound traffic at the railroad crossing between Bonita Ave. and Arrow Hwy.
 - ✓ Wheeler Ave. (northbound and southbound) will serve as the northbound detour route, see details.
 - ✓ Foothill Blvd. (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to thru traffic.
 - ✓ Arrow Hwy (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to all traffic.

NOTE TO RESIDENTS / BUSINESS OWNERS

- Noise from construction equipment will be produced near the active work zones.
- Bus stops may be temporarily relocated, for more information:
