## NOTICE: San Dimas Station & Parking Construction

### SAN DIMAS AVE. NORTH OF COMMERCIAL ST. (CITY OF SAN DIMAS) ONGOING THRU DECEMBER 2024

#### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

As part of the 9.1-mile Foothill Gold Line light rail project, crews are building the San Dimas Gold Line Station on San Dimas Ave. north of Commercial St. in the city of San Dimas. At the same time, crews are building a dedicated 289-space parking facility directly west of the station on San Dimas Ave, north of Commercial St.

#### WHEN

Ongoing thru December, 2024

- Work Hours: 7:00 AM - 8:00 PM, Monday thru Saturday. NOTE: Occasional longer work hours and construction on Sundays may be performed during the period.

#### WHERE

- Construction activities will take place within the rail corridor and north of Commercial St., between San Dimas Ave. and Monte Vista Ave.

#### TRAFFIC ADVISORIES

Intermittent lane closures will be in place on San Dimas Ave. for final crossing operations, deliveries of large equipment, or parking facility operations. During lane closures, thru traffic will be maintained via at least one lane of traffic in each direction. Thru traffic and access to residential areas and businesses will be maintained at all times.

#### NOTE TO RESIDENTS

Typical noise from construction equipment will be produced near the active work zones, including the use of trucks and light plants.

#### STAY SAFE

Please obey all posted construction signs and do not enter the construction work zone.
