This work requires the full closure of the northbound lanes on Barranca Ave. at the railroad crossing for one day only.

TRAFFIC ADVISORIES

- Barranca Ave. will be fully closed to northbound vehicular and pedestrian traffic between Devon Ct. and Elderberry Dr. at the railroad crossing.
- Barranca Ave. southbound lanes will remain open to thru traffic.
- Access to homes north and south of the railroad crossing will be maintained at all times.

PLAN YOUR ROUTE AND BE PREPARED


- A detour route (see map below) will be in place during the closure and signage will be posted to direct motorists and pedestrians. Please follow detour signs.
 - ✓ Barranca Ave. will be fully closed to all northbound traffic at the railroad crossing.
 - ✓ Barranca Ave. southbound lanes and sidewalks will remain open and accessible.
 - ✓ Grand Ave. (northbound and southbound) will serve as the northbound detour route, see details below.
 - ✓ Bennett Ave. & Foothill Blvd. (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to thru traffic.

- Noise from construction equipment will be produced near the active work zones.
