NOTICE: Intermittent Lane Closures

WHITE AVE. BETWEEN 6TH & ARROW HWY. (CITY OF LA VERNE) AUGUST 17, 2024 (ONE DAY ONLY)

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

As part of the 9.1-mile Foothill Gold Line light rail project, crews will be slurry sealing/paving White Ave. between 6th St. and the railroad crossing (just north of Arrow Highway). This work requires intermittent lane closures for one day only. Thru traffic and access to businesses and residences will be maintained. NOTE: On a separate day following these paving operations, new striping will be painted that will include two northbound lanes, one southbound lane (shared with bicycles) and a center auxiliary lane for left turns.

WHEN

Saturday, August 17th, 2024, 7:00 AM - 4:00 PM (one day only).

TRAFFIC ADVISORIES

- White Ave. will experience intermittent lane closures between 6th St. and the railroad crossing just north of Arrow Highway to slurry seal/pave the street.
- Thru access for vehicles and pedestrian will be maintained at all times with reduced lanes. Expect delays.
- Access to homes and businesses within the work zones between Arrow Hwy, and 6th St. on White Ave.
 will be maintained at all times.

PLAN YOUR ROUTE AND BE PREPARED


Alternate routes will remain open during the lane closures. Signage will be posted to direct motorists and pedestrians. Please follow all signs.
