NOVEMBER 18 - NOVEMBER 22, 2024 (CITY OF SAN DIMAS)

Beginning Monday, November 18th thru Friday, November 22nd, between the hours of 7:00 AM - 5:00 PM, Eucla Ave., Cataract Ave., and Walnut Ave. will be repaved and restriped. using directional lane closures. During the work, no parking will be allowed on the City streets within the paving zones. Please see map below for work zones and open detour routes.

- Walnut Ave. (between Arrow Hwy & Bonita Ave.) - Grind roadway - Nov. 18th, Pave roadway - Nov. 19th
- Cataract Ave. (between Arrow Hwy & Bonita Ave.) - Grind roadway - Nov. 20th, Pave roadway - Nov. 21st
- Eucla Ave. (between Bonita Ave. & 2nd St.) - Grind & pave roadway - Nov. 22nd

TRAFFIC ADVISORIES

- Temporary No Parking on Eucla Ave., between Bonita Ave. and 2nd St.
- Temporary No Parking on Cataract Ave., between Arrow Hwy & Bonita Ave.
- All driveways on Eucla Ave., Cataract Ave., and Walnut Ave. will be restricted during the paving operations between the hours of 7:00AM - 5:00PM.
- All paving will take place under directional closures, use open alt routes in green (shown below) during operations.
- Access to all residences within the work zones will be maintained via pedestrian access/sidewalk.

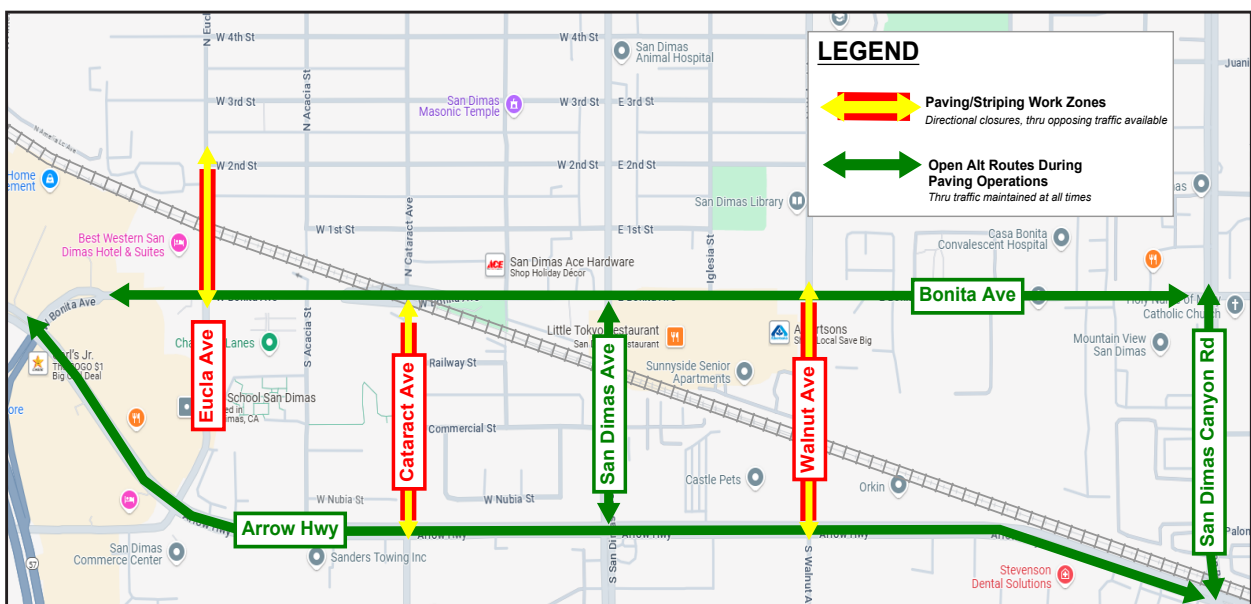
NOTE TO RESIDENTS/ BUSINESS OWNERS
