# Temporary Daytime Active Train Testing

(CITIES OF LA VERNE & POMONA)

NOVEMBER 19 - NOVEMBER 22, 2024 (FOUR DAYS ONLY)

## CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

The ongoing active train testing for the Foothill Gold Line light rail project that began in July, and has occurred mostly at night, will temporarily transition to daytime hours. Train testing will include additional time being spent testing each grade crossing (impacted crossings listed below). **During the four-day period trains will run at higher speeds (up to 55 MPH) and test equipment at San Dimas Canyon Rd., Wheeler Ave., A St., D St., E St., White Ave., and Fulton Rd.** Active train testing is expected to move back to nighttime shifts after this four-day period. Local Police, County Sheriffs, and onsite flagger support will continue during these operations to direct traffic.

## WHEN

Active Train Testing will occur Tuesday, November 19th thru Friday November 22nd during daytime working hours of 7:00AM - 4:00PM between San Dimas Canyon Rd (San Dimas) and Fulton Rd (La Verne/Pomona). Expect extra testing to take place at each crossing, requiring more gate down time as follows: (NOTE: The dates for focused testing at each crossing may need to change during this period):

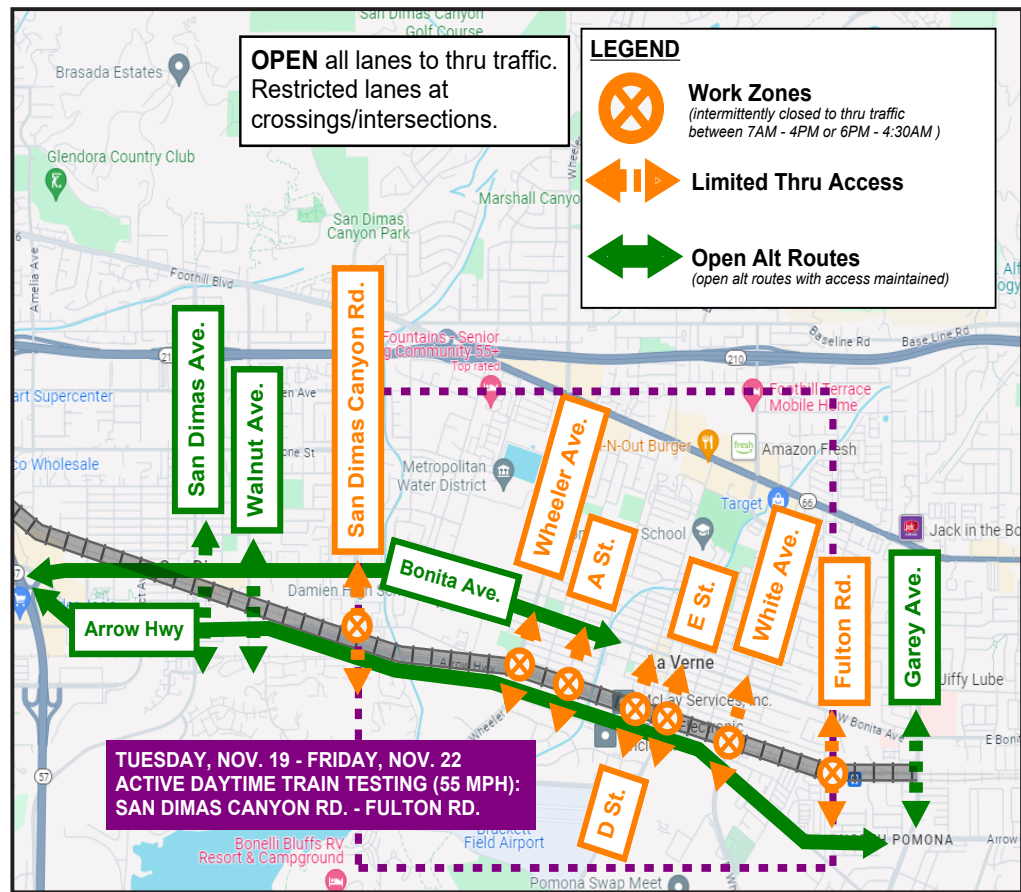
- Tuesday, November 19th: San Dimas Canyon Rd., & Wheeler Ave.
- Wednesday, November 20th: A St., D St, E St.
- Thursday, November 21st: White Ave.
- Friday, November 22nd: Fulton Rd.

## TRAFFIC ADVISORIES

- **Trains will be running at high speeds (up to 55 MPH) during daytime hours.**
- Crossing gate arms will drop throughout the work shift when testing is taking place.
- Vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be stopped when gates are down and resume as normal once gate arms are raised.

## NOTE TO RESIDENTS

- Never walk on the train tracks, go around the lowered gates, and follow all safety instructions.
- Obey all warning signs and watch for trains from both directions.
