NOTICE: Full Street Closure

E ST. AT RAILROAD CROSSING (CITY OF LA VERNE)

JANUARY 3, 2025 (ONE-DAY ONLY)

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

As part of the 9.1-mile Foothill Gold Line light rail project, crews will be placing the foundations for the new La Verne City sign that will span across E St., north of the crossing (north of Arrow Hwy, south of 1st St.). Crews will install the foundation under a one-day full closure of E St. at the railroad crossing

NOTE: The team will return for a 5-day full closure to set the sign in the first quarter of 2025. A separate notice will be provided for this closure.

WHEN

Friday, January 3rd, 2025 (one-day only), E St. will be fully closed to all traffic (vehicular and pedestrian) at the railroad crossing. Crews will be working under City approved work hours of 7:00 AM - 8:00 PM.

TRAFFIC ADVISORIES

- E St. will be fully closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic at the railroad crossing just north of Arrow Hwy.
- Access to homes and businesses on E St. within the closure area north and south of the railroad crossing will be maintained at all times, as well as access to the University of La Verne dorms (via the alley between 1st St. and 2nd St.), 1st St., 2nd St., and 3rd St.

PLAN YOUR ROUTE AND BE PREPARED

- A detour route (see map below) will be in place during the closure and signage will be posted to direct motorists and pedestrians. Please follow detour signs.
 - ✓ E St. will be fully closed to all traffic at the railroad crossing between Arrow Hwy. and Bonita Ave.
 - ✓ White Ave. (northbound and southbound) will serve as the main detour route, see details below.
 - ✓ Arrow Hwy. (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to thru traffic with reduced lanes.
 - ✓ Bonita Ave. (eastbound and westbound) will remain open to all traffic.

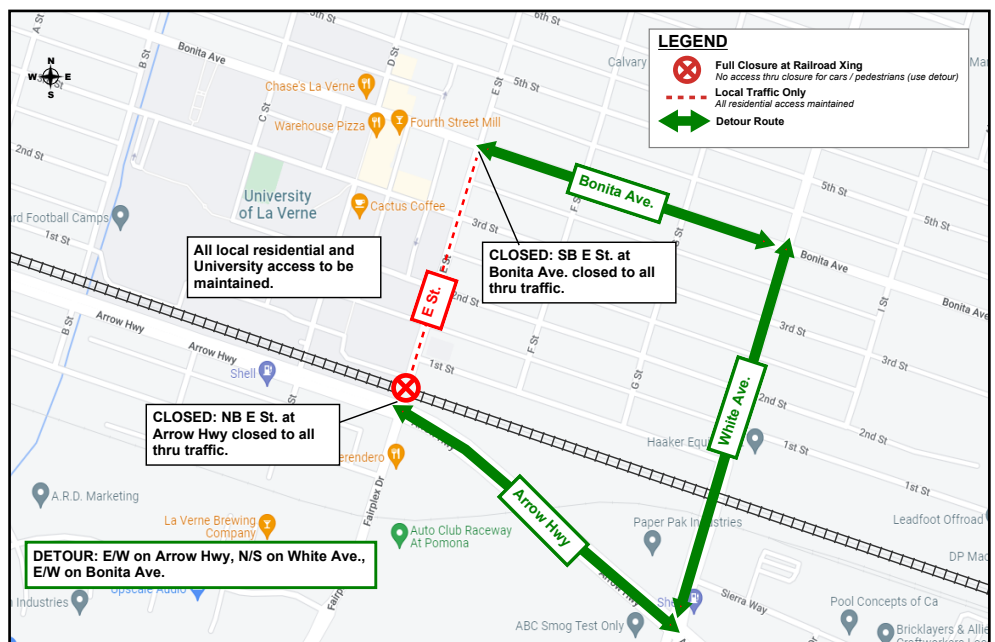
NOTE TO RESIDENTS / BUSINESS OWNERS
